**ORDER**

The complaint is registered on the basis of g-mail intimation dated 27-04-2020 of the Chief Superintendent of Central Prison, Bengaluru. It is reported that Rangappa, U.T.P No: 1780/2020, S/o Kemparangappa, aged about 60 years and R/o Sungattahalli, Tubagere Hobli, Doddabalapur Taluk, Bengaluru Rural District was remanded to judicial custody in S.C. No: 10007/2020 (Crime No: 267/19) u/s 498 (A), 302, 323, 44 R/w 34 I.P.C. It is further reported that on 27-04-2020, at 07.00 a.m., aforesaid prisoner was lying unconscious in Room No – 6 of Barrack No – 6 and hence he was taken to Jayanagara Civil Hospital, Bengaluru where he was declared 'brought dead' at 07.40 a.m.

The inquest was conducted by IX A.C.M.M. Court, Bengaluru. It is reported that the relatives of the deceased prisoner have not expressed any doubt

regarding the cause of his death and there were no external injuries on the body of the deceased.

The final opinion submitted by Department of Forensic Medicine, Victoria Hospital, Bengaluru and magisterial enquiry report in U.D.R No: 38/2020 u/s 176 (1-A) of Code of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 state that the death was due to cardiac failure as a result of coronary artery disease.

The final opinion of I/c I.G.P of the Commission states that the death of the prisoner was due to cardiac failure as a result of coronary artery disease.

In view of the material placed on record, the Commission does not find indication of any suspicious circumstance to enquire further into the complaint. Accordingly, the case is disposed and proceeding is closed without any recommendation.
