ORDER

The complaint is registered on the basis of g-mail intimation dated 04-04-2020 of the Asst. Superintendent of District Prison, Kolar. It is reported that Yashodha, W.U.T.P No: 3057, W/o Velangani, aged about 51 years and R/o #5/8, North Wall Road, Konditop, Chennai was remanded to judicial custody in C.C. No: 11/20 u/s 34 of Karnataka Excise Act, 1965. It is further reported that on 04-04-2020, the prisoner was suffering abdomen pain and hence she was shifted to Shri Narasimharaja District Hospital for treatment at 10.45 a.m. where she died on the same day at 11.15 a.m., due to failed treatment.

The inquest was conducted by Prl. C.J (Senior Division) & J.M.F.C Court, Kolar. It is reported that the relatives of the deceased prisoner have not expressed any doubt regarding the cause of her death and there were no external injuries on the body of the deceased.

The final opinion submitted by Department of Forensic Medicine, Shri Narasimharaja District Hospital, Kolar and magisterial enquiry report in U.D.R No: 06/2020 u/s 176 (1-A) of Code of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 state that the death was due to cardio respiratory failure as a result of disease of the heart and lungs.

The final opinion of I/c of I.G.P of the Commission states that the death of the prisoner was due to cardio respiratory failure as a result of disease of the heart and lungs.

In view of the material placed on record, the Commission does not find indication of any suspicious circumstance to enquire further into the complaint. Accordingly, the case is disposed and proceeding is closed without any recommendation.
