ORDER

The complaint is registered on the basis of g-mail intimation dated 18-04-2019 of the Chief Superintendent of Central Prison, Bengaluru. It is reported that Nazeer Ahmed, S/o Baba Saheb, U.T.P No: 1008/19, aged about 55 years and R/o #353, 2nd Cross, 9th Main Road, Karnataka Vidyuth Karkane (Kavika) Layout, Bapujinagar, Bengaluru was remanded to judicial custody in Cr. No: 431/18 u/s 302, 201 I.P.C. It is further reported that aforesaid prisoner was suffering from diabetes, high blood pressure, paralysis and septicaemia and on 03-04-2019, he was shifted to Victoria Hospital as he was seriously unwell. It is stated

that the prisoner died on 17-04-2019 at 10.00 p.m. at Victoria Hospital.

The inquest was conducted by XXII A.C.M.M. Court, Bengaluru. It is reported that the relatives of the deceased prisoner have not expressed any doubt regarding the cause of his death and there were no external injuries on the body of the deceased.

The post-mortem report submitted by Victoria Hospital, Bengaluru; magisterial enquiry report in U.D.R No: 36/2019 u/s 176 (1-A) of Code of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 and the final opinion of I/c I.G.P of the Commission state that the death was due to cardiac failure as a result of acute myocardial infarction associated with lobar pneumonia and empyema.

Further, notice was issued to the Chief Superintendent of Central Prison, Bengaluru to submit the medical record pertaining to deceased prisoner for having been provided any treatment at the prison hospital. Accordingly, medical record pertaining to the

deceased prisoner was received vide letter dated 29-06-2020 and they are perused.

In view of the material placed on record, the Commission does not find indication of any suspicious circumstance to enquire further into the complaint. Accordingly, the case is disposed and proceeding is closed without any recommendation.
