ORDER

The complaint is registered on the basis of g-mail intimation dated 21-08-2019 of the Commissioner of Police, Mangaluru. It is reported that H.M. Raju, U.T.P No: 13664, S/o Muthu alias Shanthu Poojari, aged about 42 years and R/o Magadi Kodige House, Halasulige Village & Post, Sakleshpura, Hassan District was remanded to judicial custody in Cr. No: 276/2013 u/s 341, 504, 323, 353 I.P.C. It is further reported that the prisoner complained of illness and hence he was shifted to Government Wenlock Hospital on 20-08-2019 where, he died on the same day at 02.02 p.m.

The inquest was conducted by II J.M.F.C Court, Mangaluru. It is reported that the relatives of the deceased prisoner have not expressed any doubt regarding the cause of his death and there were no external injuries on the body of the deceased.

The post-mortem report and final opinion submitted by Wenlock Hospital, Mangaluru; magisterial enquiry report in U.D.R No: 53/2019 u/s 176 (1-A) of Code of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 and the final opinion of I/c of I.G.P of the Commission state that the death was due to complications of chronic coronary artery disease.

In view of the material placed on record, the Commission does not find indication of any suspicious circumstance to enquire further into the complaint. Accordingly, the case is disposed and proceeding is closed without any recommendation.
