ORDER

The complaint is registered on the basis of g-mail intimation dated 30-09-2019 of the Chief Superintendent, Central Prison, Belagavi. It is reported that Budram Singh, C.T.P No: 3270, S/o Bale Singh, aged about 34 years and R/o Buravanki village, Khanapura, Belagavi District was convicted in S.C No: 20/2015 u/s 366, 376 I.P.C and Section 4,5 (1) and 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and he was sentenced to undergo imprisonment for 10 years and fine of Rs. 20,000/- in default, 4 years imprisonment by Prl. District & Sessions Court, Karwar, Uttara Kannada District. It is further reported that aforesaid prisoner was suffering from tuberculosis and H.I.V diseases and he was shifted to District Hospital on 29-09-2019 where he was declared 'brought dead' at 04.50 p.m.

The inquest was conducted by IV J.M.F.C Court, Belagavi. It is reported that the relatives of the deceased prisoner have not expressed any doubt regarding the cause of his death and there were no external injuries on the body of the deceased.

The post-mortem report submitted by B.I.M.S, Hospital, Belagavi; magisterial enquiry report in U.D.R No: 44/2019 u/s 176 (1-A) of Code of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 and the final opinion of I/c I.G.P of the Commission state that the death was due to respiratory failure as a result of lung disease and its complication.

In view of the material placed on record, the Commission does not find indication of any suspicious circumstance to enquire further into the complaint. Accordingly, the case is disposed and proceeding is closed without any recommendation.
